## The Seabird, Oceanside

This seaside <u>escape</u> is home to plenty of mesmerizing venues for extravagant weddings or more small-scale ones. Either way, this is a location for couples who appreciate playful decor. It's in the midst of the Oceanside Arts District and boasts artwork curated by Oceanside Museum of Art—and easy access to the Pacific Ocean and a sandy beach, of course. (Not to mention no-brainer train access from Los Angeles and San Diego.) There are 226 indulgent guest rooms plus a pool deck, a cabana called The Shelter Club, Sunny's Spa and Beauty Lounge (the farm-to-sea treatments are a pre-ceremony must), and a library. There is also a robust "Little Seabirds" program making it extremely family friendly. The nearly 20,000 square feet of event spaces (40,000 square feet if you count sister resort <u>Mission Pacific</u>) are complemented by farm-to-table cuisine that defines SoCal.
